**Traffic** was listed as the **first** or **second** priority by **18** of 29 respondents (62%)  
**Development** was listed **first** or **second** by **12** of 29 (41%)  
**Parks** **12** of 29 (41%)  
**Neighborhood crime watch** **9** of 29 (31%)  
**Schools** **4** of 29 (14%)

I then “weighted” the responses by giving **15** points to a **#1** priority;  
**10** points to a **#2** priority; **7** to a **#3** priority; **5** to a **#4**; **3** to a **#5**; and **1** to a **#6**:

The “weighted” scores are:
